Caterina Riva is the new director of ARTSPACE NZ. Prior to that she has been one of the founders and directors of FormContent, a project space in London, (2007-2010). Riva studied in Italy and the UK where she received her MFA in Curating at Goldsmiths College, University of London. Riva has worked on a number of exhibitions, publications and events including The young people visiting our ruins see nothing but a style at GAM, Turin, Italy (2009), The Responsive Subject at MuZee, Ostend, Belgium, (2010), and The Filmic Conventions at FormContent, London (2010). Previously she was the coordinator of the Advanced Course in Visual Arts for Fondazione Ratti in Como, Italy, from 2004 to 2008 working alongside young international artists and distinguished visiting professors such as Alfredo Jaar, Marjetica Potrc, Joan Jonas and Yona Friedman. She participated in the 6th Berlin Biennale's curatorial workshop (2010), and was curator in residence at Gertrude Contemporary, Melbourne. Australia (2010). Riva has contributed as a writer to a number of artists' books and publications, and to art magazines in Italy, France, Australia, France and Switzerland.
