



Gabriela Salgado is an Argentine-born curator. She has been based in London from 1995-2017, and holds an MA in Curating Contemporary Art from the Royal College of Art. She currently lives and works in Aotearoa New Zealand, where she is Artistic Director of Te Tuhi Contemporary Art.

Gabriela has curated a large number of exhibitions and has lectured in over twenty countries.

She specialized in Latin American art as curator of the Latin American Art Collection at Essex University, UECLAA (1999-2005) and was curator of Public Programmes at Tate Modern (2006-2011). She curated *La Otra Bienal* in Bogotá, Colombia (2013) and the 2nd Biennale of Thessaloniki, Greece (2009) and acted as jury member for the Prince Claus Awards, Holland, and Videobrasil Festival, Brazil. In 2011 she set up 'Transatlantic Connections' a programme of creative exchanges for African and Latin American artists.
