



## Conditions of Entry

- Entrants must be aged 16 - 25 years at 1 September 2018.
- Entry is open to those who reside or attend school in the prescribed area. Please check boundaries and eligibility carefully using the Area of Eligibility guidelines.
- Entries must be submitted at times shown on entry form (and below). No other arrangements will be entered into.
- Entries must be delivered to Mt Eden Village Centre, Ngauruhoe St, Mt Eden Village on Thursday 30 August 5 – 7pm or Friday 31 August 12 – 4pm.
- Entrants must deliver their work in person.
- Entrants may submit up to two works. Each work needs a separate entry form.
- Entrants must produce ID showing age and residential address or proof of attendance at school.
- Work must be exhibition ready (ie ready to hang/ strung/ with hook eyes/ pins etc as appropriate). Note that the venue has a unique hanging system using wires and hooks (no nails). Foam boards must be strung – blu tack is not sufficient.
- Name/ address/ phone number must be on back of all work.
- Size – work must not exceed 1 metre in any direction.
- A short statement about the work and the artist should be supplied.
- If work is to be offered for sale it must have the price attached. A 25% commission will apply.
- Eden Arts reserves the right not to exhibit a work of art.
- No responsibility is accepted by organisers for loss or damage to artworks.
- Entrants must attend the awards ceremony in person to receive awards. You should not enter if you know you are unable to attend the awards ceremony.
- Eden Arts reserves the right to use its discretion in the allocation of prizes.
- Works must be collected from Mt Eden Village Centre on Sunday 2 September 3pm - 5pm. No works will be held after 5pm.
- The decision of the judge(s) is final.
